What is family violence?

Family violence is harmful to you and your family. It could be in the form of:

- Hurtful words
- Threats and threatening gestures
- Actual physical harm to people, property, pets, etc.
- Withholding affection and / or unwanted sexual contact
- Controlling finances

Why does violence happen?

People are not born 'angry.' Violent behaviour is often modelled for us within the family, community or what is witnessed in the media.

Family Support and Intervention Program

This is a community-based program designed to help build relationships free from violence.

Violence is always wrong. This program is about change, not blame or shame.

This program is:

- Two groups, one for men and one for women. Child therapy also available.
- 13 weeks, offered twice a year (January and September) in the evenings
- Available to residents of Beaumont, Devon, Leduc and Leduc County
- Confidential - information will not be shared without consent
